## ANTIGONE

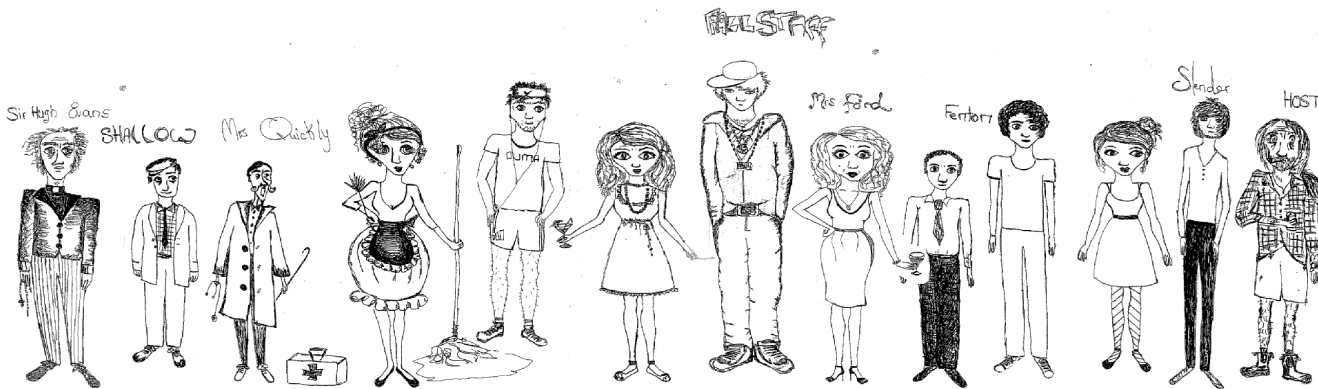
